



Relocation Support Policies in Rokunohe

Prompted Rokunohe to develop own policies to curb depopulation

Relocation Support Policy

⇒Prompted policies to help young couples & families to relocate in Rokunohe

CLAIR

Measures

- 1) Medical subsidies for infants & children
- Support for out-of-pocket expenses from the national health insurance program

0 to 6 age: 20%, 6 to 15 age: 30%

Out-of-pocket → Free! \$0

- OCommenced in 2008
- OChildren aged 15 and under
- Scope: medicine, tests and services covered by the national health insurance program



1) Medical subsidies for infants & children

Average annual medical expenses per child

Age	Out of Pocket		
0 to 4	\$430		
5 to 9	\$314		
10 to 14	\$244		
15 to 19	\$291		

Rokunohe will pay for these expenses!

Families with two children \Rightarrow save around \$700 annually

key: an environment that gives young families peace of mind

- 2) Relocation support for young couples and families
- Rental assistance for young couples & families
- ○Commenced in 2009
- OMaximum of approx. \$230/month for two years
- OEligibility: Married couples younger than 40
 - Agree to rent property for two years
 - All parties register as residents
 - Pay taxes on time
 - XAII subsidies must be paid back if rental term is less than two years

- 2) Relocation support for young couples and families
- Average monthly rent in Japan (1 room=approx. 45m²)

Aomori Prefecture: \$616

→correspond to approximately 37% of monthly rent!!!

%Tokyo: \$1,442

*The financial assistance (\$230) is similar to the subsidy from workplaces

The impact is quite large!!

Ex) \$616 (monthly rent)

- \$230 (Rokunohe)

- \$230 (workplace)

= \$156

- 2) Relocation support for young couples and families
- Approx. 2 per cent population growth(2010~2016)
 - → move in 218 person
- To help people have the opportunity to live in Rokunohe
- Support for two years as young couples and families transition from rental property to their own new home
 - → Financial support for construction of new housing





- 3) Financial support for construction of new housing
- OFinancial assistance to partially offset housing construction costs
- OCommenced in 2011
- OAmount: Three per cent of housing construction costs (up to approx. \$5,800)

Young couples under 40 get an additional \$1,160

- Eligibility: Resident registration for their new propertyAgree to live in property for at least three years

 - Pay taxes on time
 - ※All subsidies must be paid back if residents leave new property in less than three years





- 3) Financial support for construction of new housing
- Approx. 4.8 per cent population growth(2011~2015)
 - → move in 504 person
- increase in new housing construction since 2011

table: a number of new housing construction

Results


OPopulation Growth

10,524 people (in 2011) \Rightarrow 10,901 people (in 2016)

net increase 3.5 % (377 people)


82.4% of 1,719 municipalities have depopulation
