## Rules:

- 1. Maximum of ten students and two teachers per team (on one table).
- 2. Each school can have up to two tables so a maximum of 20 students per school
- 3. We recommended one school per table, but if you need to join with another school you can, the limit however is two different schools per table.
- 4. The winning table (in first place) will be given one \$500 voucher to J B Hi-Fi for their school. This will be given to the teacher attending.
- 5. Each student on the winning team will be awarded a \$30 <u>Australian Booksellers</u> voucher.
- 6. If there are two schools on the winning table (in first place) they will be awarded a \$250 voucher to J B Hi-Fi each. The teachers from each school will be given the voucher.
