

## **UTS Prize Conditions of Award**

### **Outstanding Student Award for Postgraduate Coursework Students**

#### **Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences**

This document sets out the conditions of award for the Outstanding Student Award for Postgraduate Coursework Students and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and UTS in regards to this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

#### **1. PRIZE TITLE/NAME:**

Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences Outstanding Student Award for Postgraduate Coursework Student

#### **2. PURPOSE**

To reward postgraduate students who achieve consistently outstanding results in their programme.

#### **3. VALUE AND BENEFIT**

##### **3.1 Number of Recipients:**

- One recipient from 'Master' program in each School level will be awarded the Prize.
- One recipient from 'Graduate Diploma' program in each School will be awarded the Prize.
- Two candidates of equal merit may be recommended for a joint award of the Outstanding Student Award for Postgraduate Students

##### **3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:**

The prize includes a transcribed certificate, presented to the Recipient at the FASS prize giving night.

##### **3.3 Payment of benefit/s:**

#### **4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

To be eligible for the Prize, a candidate must meet all of the following criteria:

- Must be a full or part time students in any Postgraduate Coursework degree (Graduate Diploma & Masters) in the School of Communication, School of Education or School of International Studies in The Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences.
- Have graduated from UTS Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences.

#### **5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA:**

- In each School, the prize will be awarded to the student who has been ranked as outstanding on their academic achievement across all graded subjects in their:
  - Master program
  - Graduate Diploma program

#### **6. SELECTION**

- Students with an overall WAM of 85 or above in all graded subjects in their Masters and in Graduate Diplomas

- School Teaching and Learning Committee will recommend the winner based on the highest WAM for Master program and Graduate Diploma program in each School
- Head of School and/or the Dean or their delegate to approve the recommendation
