I am writing this letter regarding the unfortunate incident Removed under GIPA Act involving [REDACTED], a University of Technology Sydney (UTS) student from China. I would like to take this opportunity to express my deep sympathy to [REDACTED]. I hope [REDACTED] will recover quickly from the injuries [REDACTED] sustained and return to normal life and study as soon as possible.

The safety and wellbeing of our students is our highest priority at UTS. UTS Student Services staff worked closely with the hospital when [REDACTED] was admitted and offered [REDACTED] direct support as soon as we were alerted of the incident, providing [REDACTED] assistance and counselling and has been in touch since. We are very glad to know that [REDACTED] situation is improving and that [REDACTED] has been discharged from the hospital.

UTS will continue to provide whatever assistance [REDACTED] requires to recover from this traumatic experience. We have also been working closely with the NSW Police to assist in the investigation of this case and hopefully the perpetrator can be brought to justice in a speedy manner.

I understand that staff from the Consulate General have visited [REDACTED] and have also provided [REDACTED] with valuable support. Your care for our student is highly appreciated.
