

UTS Prize Conditions of Award Francis E. Feledy Memorial Prize

Faculty: Design, Architecture Building (DAB)

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below prize ('Prize') and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and UTS in regards to this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

1. PRIZE NAME: Francis E. Feledy Memorial Prize

2. PURPOSE

To support academic excellence in part-time students entering their final year in the Faculty of Design, Architecture and Building.

3. VALUE AND BENEFIT

3.1 Number of Recipients:

• One (1) recipient will be awarded the Prize in each calendar year.

3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:

• The award will be in the form of a cash prize of \$1,000.

3.3 Payment of benefit/s:

• The Recipient will receive one payment of \$1,000, made by electronic funds transfer to his/her nominated bank account.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for the Prize, a candidate must meet all of the following criteria:

- Be entering their final year of study in any of the following courses:
 - Bachelor of Construction Project Management (C10214)
 - Bachelor of Design in Architecture (C10004)
 - Bachelor of Property Economics (C10310)
 - The above degrees combined with any other degree
- Have been enrolled part-time in the academic year for which the award is made.

5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA, IN PRIORITY ORDER

- The Prize will be awarded to the student who has obtained the highest WAM over the course of their studies.
- Where two (2) or more students achieve the highest WAM over the course of their studies, the student (1) with the highest overall Grade Point Average (GPA) in their course will be awarded the Prize.

6. SELECTION

- The recipient will be selected by the Faculty of Design, Architecture and Building.
- The highest WAM and overall GPA is obtained from Faculty Academic Programs Office.
- There is no selection committee for this award.
- The recipient will be approved by the Dean of the Faculty of Design, Architecture and Building (or their nominee).
