



# UTS Prize Conditions of Award

## Jack Greenland Environmental Studies Prize

### Faculty: Design, Architecture Building (DAB)

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below prize ('Prize') and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and UTS in regards to this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

#### **1. PRIZE NAME: Jack Greenland Environmental Studies Prize**

#### **2. PURPOSE**

To reward academic excellence in environmental studies in Bachelor of Design in Architecture.

#### **3. VALUE AND BENEFIT**

##### **3.1 Number of Recipients:**

- One (1) recipient will be awarded the Prize in each calendar year.

##### **3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:**

- The award will be in the form of a cash prize of \$1,000.

##### **3.3 Payment of benefit/s:**

- The Recipient will receive one payment of \$1,000, made by electronic funds transfer to his/her nominated bank account.

#### **4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

To be eligible for the Prize, a candidate must meet all of the following criteria:

- Be enrolled in the:
  - Bachelor of Design in Architecture (C10004); or
  - The above course combined with any other degree; and
- Have completed the subject 11225 Thermal Design and Environmental Control and 11232 Lighting, Acoustics and Advanced Environmental Control, with the latter completed subject completed in the relevant academic year for which the award is made.

#### **5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA**

- The Prize will be awarded to the student who has obtained the highest Weighted Average Mark (WAM) over the subjects 11225 Thermal Design and Environmental Control and 11232 Lighting, Acoustics and Advanced Environmental Control.
- Where two (2) or more students achieve the Weighted Average Mark (WAM) over the subjects 11225 Thermal Design and Environmental Control and 11232 Lighting, Acoustics and Advanced Environmental Control, the student (1) with the highest overall Grade Point Average (GPA) in their course will be awarded the Prize.

#### **6. SELECTION**

- The recipient will be selected by the Faculty of Design, Architecture and Building.
- The highest mark and overall GPA is obtained from Faculty Academic Programs Office.
- There is no selection committee for this award.
- The recipient will be approved by the Dean of the Faculty of Design, Architecture and Building (or their nominee).
