ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- **Qualifications:** Applicants must have completed a UTS recognised Bachelor or Master of Pharmacy degree, or equivalent.
- **Registration:** Applicants must hold current registration as a pharmacist with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) or equivalent body.

Students who have already obtained Medication Management Review (MMR) Accreditation are eligible to enrol into the Advanced Medication Management stream of this course. All other students are required to enrol into the Standard stream where they undertake accreditation as part of their course.

- **Interview:** Selected applicants are required to undertake a short interview. Applicants are assessed in the areas of communication skills, interpersonal skills, and motivation for pursuing this qualification.
