



UTS Prize Conditions of Award

The Toby's Estate Closed Loop Design Prize

Faculty: Design, Architecture Building (DAB)

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below prize ('Prize') and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and UTS in regards to this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

1. PRIZE NAME: The Toby's Estate Closed Loop Design Prize

2. PURPOSE

To encourage academic excellence in Product Design.

3. VALUE AND BENEFIT

3.1 Number of Recipients:

- Five (5) recipients will be awarded the Prize in each calendar year.

3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:

- The award will be in the form of five (5) cash prizes of \$1,000.

3.3 Payment of benefit/s:

- The five (5) recipients will receive one payment of \$1,000, made by electronic funds transfer to his/her nominated bank account.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for the Prize, a candidate must meet all of the following criteria:

- Have completed the subject:
 - 84000 Industrial Design Special Project

5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA, IN PRIORITY ORDER

- The Prize will be awarded to the five (5) students who have obtained the highest mark in the subject 84000 Industrial Design Special Project or its equivalent replacement subject.

6. SELECTION

- The recipient will be selected by the Faculty of Design, Architecture and Building.
- The highest mark and overall GPA is obtained from Faculty Academic Programs Office.
- There is no selection committee for this award.
- The recipients will be approved by the Dean of the Faculty of Design, Architecture and Building (or their nominee).
