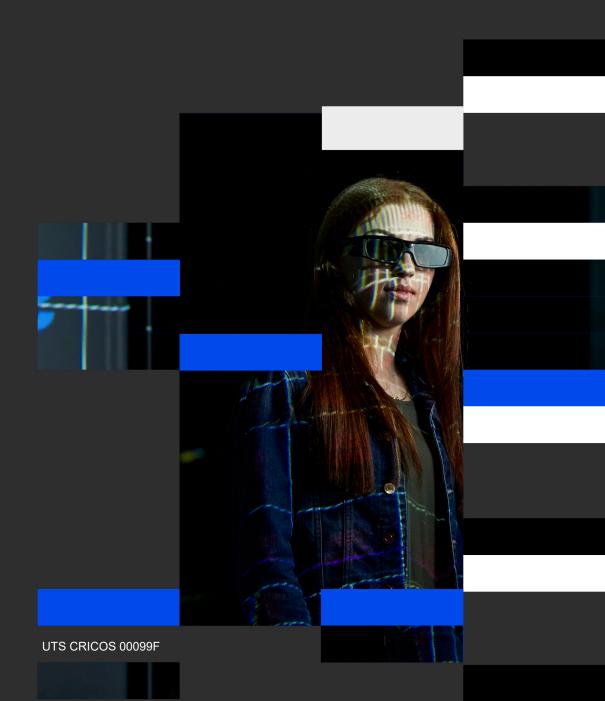
HDR Induction Checklist 2022





Induction checklist for HDR students 2022

Before you start:

- Accept your offer
- Activate your email account
- Agree on your start date with your supervisor
- · Complete your enrolment on the agreed start date

First month:

- Meet your supervisory panel
- Contact your faculty arrange access to study spaces, laboratories, etc
- Check out the resources and facilities available to you as a student
- Familiarise yourself with the policies, procedures, and frameworks that govern HDR study:
 - Graduate Research Candidature Management, Thesis Preparation and Submission Procedures
 - UTS Student Rules, especially Section 11 Graduate Research
 - Graduate Research and Supervision Policy
 - Student Rights and Responsibilities Policy
 - <u>UTS's Research Policy</u>
 - Australian Code for the Responsible Conduct of Research
- Complete your Graduate Research Study Plan in consultation with your supervisor
- Familiarise yourself with ResearchMaster
- Set up your HDR student profile on Symplectic
- Visit the UTS Library website and the library itself if you are on campus
- Attend GRS's HDR Induction or watch the recording

First session:

- Learn what regular scholarly activities your faculty, school, or discipline organises (ex. colloquia or lecture series)
- Meet members of your research centre (if you are part of one) and learn what the activities the centre
 is conducting
- Ensure you know who the HDR Student Representative is for your faculty
- Complete the online Research Integrity module
- Complete the online Consent Matters module
- Understand the requirements of a Research Data Management Plan and familiarise yourself with Stash
- Identify potential safety and ethical issues in your proposed research and understand what steps you
 must take to manage them
- In consultation with your supervisor, identify any approvals, licenses or permits you may need to carry out your research and learn how to obtain them
