CURRENT SCHOOL LEAVER PROCESS

A current school leaver (CSL) is someone who is completing Year 12, the year prior to admission.

DECEMBER - APRIL: FIRST/SECOND TERM

- Commence year 12 in Term 4
- Attend various events/outreach activities
- Apply for Co-Op Scholarships

MAY - SEPTEMBER: SECOND/THIRD TERM

Trials commence. Note - different schools run trials at different times.

Apply for Early Entry Programs and Equity Schemes (EAS/SRS).

<u>OCTOBER - DECEMBER</u>: EXAMS

- Sit the HSC/IB
- Receive HSC results + ATARS
- Attend Info Days and finalise preferences (see other information on preferencing)

<u>DECEMBER - FEBRURARY: ACCEPT AND ENROL</u>

- The first offer round CSL are eligble for is usually December Round 2 (as this is the first offer round after they receive their ATAR's.
- Offer rounds continue into Jan/Feb.
- Participate in orientation: Jan/Feb

CSL FAQ'S

- Accepting an offer does not mean they cannot receive other offers.
- Students never receive their selection rank, only their ATAR.
- There are around 2 offer rounds per month. Refer to UAC for the key dates.
- Before completing their HSC, students may receive a notification on UAC that they do not meet requirements. This is because they have not completed their HSC. This will go away once they complete their HSC.
