

UTS Prize Conditions of Award

Sydney Mechanics' School of Arts Award for Achievement in Adult Education

Faculty: Arts and Social Sciences

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below prize ('Prize') and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and the University of Technology Sydney ('UTS') about this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

1. Prize Name: Sydney Mechanics' School of Arts Award for Achievement in Adult Education

2. PURPOSE

To attract and award those students making significant contributions in the community as adult educators and achieving high academic performance in their postgraduate academic studies.

3. VALUE AND BENEFIT

3.1 Number of Recipients: Two (2) Recipients will be awarded the Prize at the end of each academic year.

3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:

- The value of the Prize to each Recipient is \$1000
- The Recipient will also receive a certificate of award.

3.3 Payment of benefit/s:

- The Recipient will receive one payment of \$1000 by electronic funds transfer to their nominated bank account: and
- A certificate of award will be presented to the Recipient at the FASS prize-giving event.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The Recipient must:

- Be enrolled or completed in the last 6 months in:
 - Master of TESOL and Applied Linguistics (C04305) or Master of TESOL and Applied Linguistics (Extension) (C04420); or
 - MEd Learning and Leadership degree (C04427)
- Have not received this award in the past

5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA, IN PRIORITY ORDER

- The prize will be awarded to the recipient of the highest GPA for the Master of TESOL and Applied Linguistics or Master of TESOL and Applied Linguistics (Extension) of the previous year.
- The prize will be awarded to the recipient of the highest GPA for the MEd Learning and Leadership of the previous year.
- If two students have the same WAM for the above degrees, both will receive a cash prize of \$500.

6. SELECTION

The Prize will be recommended by the School of International Studies and Education. Successful candidates will be approved by the Dean or their delegate in the UTS Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences.
