.21 that Rule 9, Division 3, G3 – Rules relating to the Academic Board be amended as follows (additions in bold):

The Deputy Chairs, unless they resign or cease to be members of the Board, hold office for such period (not exceeding two years) and on such conditions as may be determined by the Council on the recommendation of the Board. Should a Deputy Chair's membership of Academic Board conclude as a result of the conclusion of his or her term in an ex officio staff member position, the Deputy Chair may continue as a co-opted member of Academic Board, for a period up to the next general Academic Board election, at the Board's discretion, in order to continue or complete the work of the Board. The duties of the Deputy Chairs will be determined, from time to time, in consultation with the Chair and Deputy Chairs.
