## **RULES MADE BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR**

In accordance with the By-law (Chapter 4, clause 47), I amend existing Rule 2.1.6 of *Rules of the University relating to students enrolled in all award courses* (UTS: Calendar 2003, page 289) and delete existing Rule 3.1.11.2 of *Rules of the University relating to students enrolled in all award courses* (UTS: Calendar 2003, page 306)

The rule would be amended as follows (new text is shown in *italics*, deleted text is shown as ~~strikethrough~~):

### **2.1.6 ~~Criteria for admission~~ Admission**

- (a) Except where otherwise provided for by the ~~University Rules~~, an application for admission must be made in accordance with University policy and procedures
- (b) *Except where otherwise provided for by the University Rules, an offer of admission is made by the Registrar, or nominee.*
- (c) *The Registrar must maintain a Register of the persons authorized to make an offer of admission.*
