

Pursuant to Clause 48(1) and (2) in Division 3, Chapter 4 of the Ry-law, the following rules made by the Vice-Chancellor will take effect on 20 August 2003

RULES MADE BY THE VICE-CHANCELLOR

In accordance with the By-law (Chapter 4, clause 47), I amend existing Rule 3.5.9.1 (UTS Calendar 2003, page 324) of the Rules of the University Relating to Students.

The rule is amended as follows:

Rules of the University Relating to Students Enrolled in Particular Award Courses Rule 3.5.9.1 Candidature Assessment

(a) Before or at the end of the first two semesters of candidature in the case of a full-time student, or the first four three semesters in the case of a part-time student, the student's candidature will be assessed. The object of the Doctoral Candidature Assessment (hereafter referred to as the "Doctoral Assessment") is to ensure that the student is equipped with the knowledge to carry out his/her research program, and has made sufficient progress to make it likely that he/she will finish in the prescribed time.
