## RULE CHANGES APPROVED BY COUNCIL

---

Council resolved at meeting 04/7 (20.9.04):

COU/04/123.3

that Rule 1(1)c, (6)(b) and (c) of Rule G2, Division 1 (Election of Chancellor and Deputy Chancellor) be amended (deletions struck through, additions in bold):

1(1)(c) The notice referred to in this clause must be sent or delivered **whenever a vacancy in the office of Chancellor or Deputy Chancellor occurs or, if a vacancy is expected to occur**, no earlier than ~~one~~ **three** months and no later than ~~two weeks~~ **one month** before the ~~expiry of a term of office~~ **date of the expected vacancy**.

...

1(6)(b) After such a notification has been received the Returning Officer may proceed to conduct an election ~~no earlier than four weeks and no later than two weeks before the vacancy is expected to occur~~.

(c) The result of the election does not take effect ~~and is not to be made public~~, until after the incumbent's resignation takes effect.

The amended rule is shown below.

### **G2 - Rules on election of Chancellor and Deputy Chancellor and for Academic Board and Faculty Board elections**

#### **Division 1 - Election of Chancellor and Deputy Chancellor**

1. The following Rules apply in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Act and Note 2 to clause 6 of the By-law:

##### ***Call for nominations***

(1) ...

(c) The notice referred to in this clause must be sent or delivered whenever a vacancy in the office of Chancellor or Deputy Chancellor occurs or, if a vacancy is expected to occur, no earlier than three months and no later than one month before the date of the expected vacancy.

##### ***Election in anticipation of resignation***

(6) ...

(b) After such a notification has been received the Returning Officer may proceed to conduct an election-

(c) The result of the election does not take effect until after the incumbent's resignation takes effect.
