

APPROVED RULE CHANGES

Schedule 1 — Definitions

Subject Coordinator means a member of the academic staff nominated by a Responsible Academic Officer and appointed by the relevant Faculty Boards Dean or equivalent for each subject in accordance with the duties and powers of Faculty Boards as approved by Academic Board.
