

Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students (LANTITE)

The Literacy and Numeracy Test for Teacher Education Student (LANTITE) is designed to assess initial teacher education students' personal literacy and numeracy skills to ensure teachers are well equipped to meet the demands of teaching and assist higher education providers, teacher employers and the public to have increased confidence in the skills of graduating teachers.

All students enrolled in an initial teacher education course will be expected to sit and pass the test.

LANTITE must be attempted **during the first year** of your teacher education studies. It is best to complete and pass LANTITE as early as possible in the degree.

The table below lists the subjects that have an enrolment requisite of successful completion (pass) of both literacy and numeracy components of LANTITE. Without passing LANTITE, you will not be permitted to enrol in the subject.
