

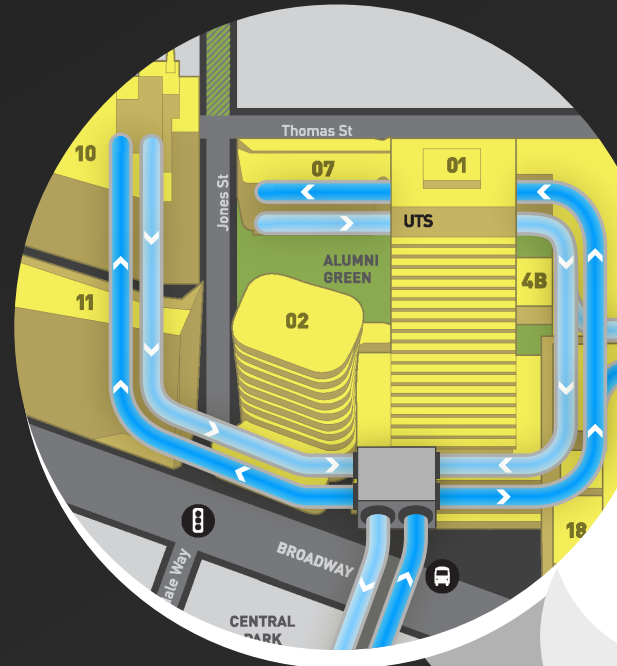
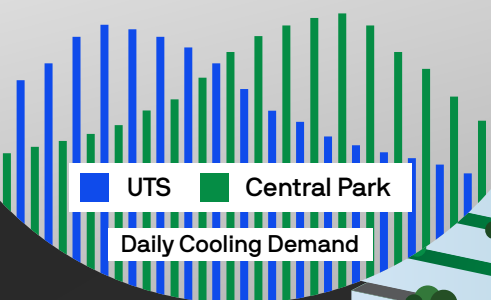
Precinct Cooling at UTS



At UTS, our spaces are cooled using chilled water which circulates around our buildings.

On top of the water that UTS chills, water travels under the road from Central Park and then all over our campus.

This means the cooling demand can be shared. We can utilise the excess cooling capacity from Central Park when their demand is low.



This builds on our precinct recycled water supply agreement, which waters our plants and flushes our toilets in Building 2. All of this cuts down on our energy use and potable water use.
