- 4. You should contact Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) concerning the current requirements for family entry.

- 5. You are responsible for the reception of family members and the accommodation of family members.
- 6. AAS does not provide health insurance for Awardees' family members. All family members on an AAS Student Dependant Visa must be covered by Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) at all times during their stay in Australia. You are responsible for the organisation and payment of OSHC and any other medical expenses for all family members while they are in Australia.
- 7. If you have been granted Reunion Travel entitlement but wish to have your family accompany you after you arrive in Australia, you must advise the UTS International Sponsored Students Team immediately and forfeit your Reunion Travel entitlement by signing a form to waive your right to Reunion Travel.
- 8. If a family member of yours is involved in a critical incident, you are responsible for all associated costs and arrangements regarding the family member(s) involved in the critical incident.
- 9. Institution may recommend scholarship suspension if your academic failure relates to health or family issues.
- 10. You are responsible for all family members whilst undertaking fieldwork. Where you will be undertaking fieldwork overseas, you must consult early with DIBP on the current policy relating to either the dependants staying in Australia or travelling with you.
- 11. Family matters are not a legitimate reason for scholarship extension.
- 12. As an AAS sponsored student, whose children and/or spouse are working or studying as private students, it is not permitted to remain in Australia after the completion of your studies to remain with your family.
- 13. The final decision of allowing you to have your family join you in Australia rests with the AAS office.
