

# **UTS Award Conditions of Award Business Deans Merit List (Postgraduate)**

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below award and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and UTS in regards to this award. The administrative processes to support awarding this award will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

#### 1. AWARD NAME

Business Deans Merit List (Postgraduate)

#### 2. PURPOSE

The Award sets out to encourage students to aspire to academic excellence.

#### 3. VALUE AND BENEFIT

# 3.1 Number of Recipients:

Various Recipients will be awarded the Award in 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025, and 2026.

## 3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:

• Inclusion of a student on a Dean's Merit List will be acknowledged in writing, will be recorded on the academic transcript of the student, and will be published on the UTS Business School website.

#### 3.3 Payment of benefit/s:

A certificate of award will be presented to the Recipient at the UTS Business School Award giving
event.

# 4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- To be eligible for inclusion on a Dean's Merit List, a student must be enrolled into a UTS Business School Masters by coursework and must have completed the course in the year for which the award is made. Students in an Extension course will be grouped with their related Masters by coursework.
- Postgraduate students undertaking studies in Masters by Research, Doctor of Philosophy or research
  professional doctorate programs are not eligible for consideration for inclusion on the Dean's Merit
  List.

# **5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA**

• The Recipient will be selected based on the top-performing graduating student with a minimum WAM of 75 in each of the UTS Business School Masters by coursework course for which the award is made.

### 6. SELECTION

• The Recipient will be nominated and approved by the Faculty Board in Business chaired by the Dean (or nominee), UTS Business School based on the selection criteria in clause 5.

# 7. OTHER CONDITIONS

- The Dean shall have discretion to determine whether to exclude a student from the Dean's Merit List where a student has satisfied the academic criteria; but:
  - a student has been found guilty of academic or other misconduct in <u>Section 16 Student</u> <u>misconduct and appeals</u> during the year in which the Dean's Merit List is being decided.
