There are no schemes restricted to particular high schools or groups of high schools.

1. Educational access scheme – inpUTS

- Eligibility criteria: Applicants who are claiming long term educational disadvantage during

- *Number of bonus points:* Nil. However, includes 10 point concession (from ATAR cut-off) as opposed to bonus points.
- Number of applicants eligible in 2010: 530 (approx. 10% of all offers)

2. Special admissions – Elite Athletes and Performers

- Eligibility criteria: Applicants claiming that there study was affected by elite level training or performing commitments. Visit www.uts.edu.au/study/pdfs/athlete_instr.pdf for more details.
- Number of bonus points: 5
- Number of applicants eligible in 2010: 89

3. Female in non-traditional areas

- Eligibility criteria: Female applicants to Construction (in Faculty of Design Architecture and Building) female applicants in the Faculty of Engineering and IT (FEIT).
- Number of bonus points: 10 for construction; 5 for engineering; 4 for IT.
- Number of applicants eligible in 2010: 401

4. Year 12 Bonus scheme

- Number of bonus points: Maximum 5
- Number of applicants eligible in 2010: 8662 out of 12222 applicants.
