

# **UTS Prize Conditions of Award**

# **UTS Anthology Writing Prize**

#### **Faculty: Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences**

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below prize ('Prize') and the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and UTS in regards to this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

#### 1. PRIZE NAME: UTS Anthology Writing Prize

#### 2. PURPOSE

To recognise excellence in writing amongst UTS Students.

#### 3. VALUE AND BENEFIT

#### 3.1 Number of Recipients:

One (1) Recipient will be awarded the Prize during the Sydney Festival Writer's week, based on work submitted in the prior academic year.

#### 3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:

- The value of the Prize to the Recipient is \$500.
- The Recipient will also receive a certificate of award.

#### 3.3 Payment of benefit/s:

- The Recipient will receive one payment of \$500 by electronic funds transfer to his/her nominated bank account.
- A certificate of award will be presented to the Recipient at the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences
  prize-giving event

## 4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for the Prize the Recipient must:

- Be enrolled in any UTS degree at the time of submission of the written piece;
- Have submitted a written piece (maximum 5000 words) in any genre that was published in the UTS Anthology.

#### 5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA

The Prize will be awarded to the student who has been judged as most outstanding based on literary merit.

#### 6. SELECTION

- The Prize winner will be selected by a committee of at least three members of the UTS community, chaired by the Dean (or their nominee). The panel will include staff from the UTS Creative Writing discipline.
- The Recipient will be selected based on the selection criteria as described in Clause 5.

### 7. OTHER CONDITIONS

- In instances where a base level criteria or criteria satisfaction is not met, the Selection Committee reserve the right not to award the Prize.
- Should the UTS Anthology not provide a royalties income of at least \$500, the Prize will not be awarded.
